

# Embedding MoSKito-Inspect into a maven-built war

## HowTo embed MoSKito Inspect into a maven built war

If you want to embed MoSKito web user interface to your webapp you can use following in your pom.

      </configuration>
      <executions>
        <execution>
          <phase>compile</phase>
          <goals>
            <goal>unpack</goal>

    </plugin>

    <plugin>
      <artifactId>maven-war-plugin</artifactId>
      <version>2.1</version>
      <configuration>
        <webXml>etc/web.xml</webXml>
        <webResources>
          . . .
          <resource>
            <directory>${project.build.directory}/tmp</directory>
          </resource>
        </webResources>
      </configuration>
    </plugin>
  </plugins>
</build>
```

You will need to declare following dependencies.
